



2022 Summer Camp COVID-19 Safety Information

Please know that the safety of our campers and our instructors is our highest priority. As such, we have several mitigation efforts with our summer camp processes. We ask that you please read the following before registering your child for theatre summer camps.

- We will defer to the COVID guidelines for children at the time of the camp. This is likely to include masks and/or face shields for campers as well as social distancing.
- We will be doing symptom checks upon arrival for all campers & instructors.
 - Student temperatures will be taken upon arrival. If a student's temperature registers as 100.4 or higher, they will be asked to wait a few minutes before the temperature is taken again. If the temperature remains 100.4 or higher, the student will be asked to go home for the day.
- All staff who will be interacting with campers will be fully vaccinated by the time the first camp session begins.
- All public spaces will be cleaned before, during, and after camps by our assistants and instructors.
- We will have frequent handwashing breaks and hand sanitizing stations around the theatre for use at any time.
- We ask that all campers and their parents to agree to adhere to these guidelines. Following them is critical. Failure to comply with these guidelines will result in your child's dismissal from the camp, without a refund of any kind. We ask for your cooperation in ensuring this code is followed so we can safely conduct the camps.

We will be closely monitoring the public health guidelines as we remain cautiously optimistic that our camps will be in full force this summer. And, we will maintain clear and consistent communication with all registrants during these next few months to keep you updated on any changes with the program.
